

Scope of Work

First Aid is of critical importance for saving lives during accidents, emergencies and disasters. Preparedness and training in the use of First Aid equips individuals and communities to respond better when needed. Schools, including teachers and students, can play an important role in developing capacity and readiness. With this view, IRCS and NDMA are developing First Aid training curriculum for imparting training to secondary, senior secondary students and school teachers across the country.

Specially, abled children need the training resources in a format suitable to them. The scope relates to making the material accessible by the visually impaired audiences through its translation in Braille.

The scope of work entails the following:

1. Braille translation of all three modules (Total no. of pages are 300-320 across all modules). Page size is double demy with images (approximately 100 in each module). **Rates may be quoted on per page basis.**
2. Delivering 5 copies of each module in braille print ready format
